NOTIFICATION

No. SO (Judl-III)4-83/2025.- In exercise of the powers conferred under section 14 of the Punjab Regulation of Kite Flying Ordinance 2025 (X of 2025), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following rules:

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be cited as the Punjab Regulation of Kite Flying Rules 2025.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Definitions.- (1) In the rules, unless the subject or context requires otherwise:

- (a) "charkhi" means a spool of any type used for winding the 'dor' around it;
- (b) "dor" means the cotton thread to be used for flying kites as specified in the Schedule-I;
- (c) "kite" means 'patang' and 'gudda' as specified in the Schedule-I;
- (d) "maanjha" means the mixture of glue, simple colour, atta (flour) and the powdered glass of the weakest type, coated on cotton thread for the purpose of kite flying as specified in the Schedule-I;
- (e) "manufacturer" means a registered person or entity to produce, assemble or process the permissible kite flying material or any part thereof for sale to trader or seller at specified place for the purpose of permissible kite flying;
- (f) "Ordinance" means the Punjab Regulation of Kite Flying Ordinance 2025 (X of 2025);
- (g) "permissible kite flying material" means 'dor', 'kite', 'maanjha' and 'pinna' or any part thereof but does not include 'charkhi' as specified in the Schedule-I;
- (h) "pinna" means 'dor' wound in a rounded ball shape mesh;
- (i) "rules" means the Punjab Regulation of Kite Flying Rules 2025;
- (j) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to the rules;
- (k) "seller" means a registered person or entity to sell the permissible kite flying material in finished form

to consumer on retail price at specified place for the purposes of permissible kite flying; and

- (1) "trader" means a registered person or entity to purchase, transport or store the permissible kite flying material at specified place for sale to the seller or any other trader.

(2) A word or expression used but not defined in the rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in the Ordinance.

3. Registration of the manufacturer, trader or seller.- (1) An online application for registration as manufacturer, trader or seller of the permissible kite flying material shall be made, in the form and manner as prescribed in the regulations, to the concerned Deputy Commissioner or his authorized officer, as the case may be, along with the following documents:

- (a) certified copy of the Computerized National Identity Card of the applicant;
- (b) proof of ownership or possession of the place of business;
- (c) passport size photograph;
- (d) receipt of payment of registration fee (non-refundable) as specified in the Schedule-II; and
- (e) any other document as prescribed in the regulations.

(2) The concerned Deputy Commissioner or his authorized officer shall, within ten days of the receipt of online application, verify the contents of application and documents.

(3) Upon verification, the concerned Deputy Commissioner or his authorized officer shall decide the application for registration and issue the certificate of registration as prescribed in the regulations.

(4) The registration shall be valid for a period of one year and may be renewed upon submission of online application and payment of non-refundable annual renewal fee as specified in the Schedule-II.

(5) A person or entity may apply for registration as a manufacturer, trader or seller or more than one category and in case of more than one category, separate application and fee shall be submitted.

(6) The manufacturer, trader or seller of the permissible kite flying material shall display the certificate of registration at a conspicuous place of his business premises as directed by the concerned Deputy Commissioner.

(7) No manufacturer, trader or seller shall manufacture, store, transport, trade or sell any kite flying material unless the kite flying material conforms to the specifications as specified in the Schedule-I.

(8) No person shall manufacture, trade, transport, sell or use a 'charkhi', 'sharp maanjha', 'dor' coated with sharp maanjha or 'kite' or 'dor' not permissible under sub-rule (7).

(9) The concerned Deputy Commissioner or his authorized officer shall maintain record of each registered manufacturer, trader or seller and share such list with general public through digital means.

4. Kite flying association.- (1) An online application for registration of kite flying association shall be submitted either by the President or General Secretary of the kite flying association in the form and manner as prescribed in the regulations to the Deputy Commissioner concerned along with the following information and documents:

- (a) name of the kite flying association;
- (b) office address of kite flying association;
- (c) landline number of kite flying association;
- (d) number of members of kite flying association;
- (e) name, computerized national identity card number and mobile number of President of kite flying association;
- (f) name, computerized national identity card number and mobile number of General Secretary of kite flying association;
- (g) names, computerized national identity card numbers and mobile numbers of each proposed member of kite flying association;
- (h) copies of the computerized national identity card of the President, General Secretary and each proposed member of kite flying association;
- (i) receipt of payment of registration fee (non-refundable) as specified in the Schedule-II; and
- (j) any other document as prescribed in the regulations.

(2) The Deputy Commissioner concerned shall, within ten days of the receipt of online application, verify the contents of application and documents.

(3) Upon verification, the concerned Deputy Commissioner shall decide the application for registration and issue the certificate of registration as prescribed in the regulations.

(4) The registration shall be valid for a period of one year and may be renewed upon submission of online application and payment of non-refundable annual renewal fee as specified in the Schedule-II.

(5) The kite flying association shall consist of members not less than ten including the President and General Secretary.

(6) The kite flying association shall:

- (a) inspect, with prior permission of the Deputy Commissioner concerned, the business premises of the manufacturers, traders or sellers to ensure implementation of the Ordinance, rules and regulations;
- (b) ensure that only the permissible kite flying material is being manufactured, stored, transported and sold as per specifications as specified in the Schedule-I;
- (c) assist the Deputy Commissioner concerned and his authorized officer in recovery and collection of prohibited kite flying material from market and persons engaged in such activity;
- (d) coordinate with the Deputy Commissioner concerned and his authorized officer in making arrangements for permissible kite flying;
- (e) organize awareness campaigns to promote permissible kite flying; and
- (f) report to the Deputy Commissioner concerned and his authorized officer about manufacture, storage, transport, trade or sale of kite flying material by unregistered manufacturers, traders, sellers or any other violation of the Ordinance, rules or regulations.

(7) The Deputy Commissioner concerned shall maintain record of membership of the kite flying association in the form and manner as prescribed in the regulations.






SCHEDULE-I

SPECIFICATIONS OF PERMISSIBLE KITE FLYING MATERIAL

1. A "**patang**" not exceeding four and half *githi* and Thirty Five Inches in width and Thirty Inches in length.
2. A "**gudda**" not exceeding one and half *tawa* and Forty inches in width and Thirty Four Inches in length.
3. "**Dor**" made of cotton with not more than nine tars (threads), and not less than twenty-eight counts, coated with "**maanjha**" having sheesha size of three hundred and fifty mash and above and wound in the shape of a "**pinna**" having specific QR code.
